Benefits at The College

- High student satisfaction levels
- High retention and progression rates
- Year 2 success on par with direct entry students
- Passionate teachers, qualified and industry relevant
- Smaller class sizes
- Heightened student support model
- Dedicated First Year Experience Coordinator for every student – to get them to graduation

Piloting a New Education Model

- Diploma in Culture, Society and Justice
- Block model = 1 subject every 4-weeks
- Set timetable 3x3hr workshops/week
- Flipped classroom – workshop style
- Transition pedagogy
- Open Entry
- One to many pathways – one Diploma, many Bachelor pathways
- One year's credit in ALL Bachelor pathways
- 'Wrap around' student support: career guidance, pastoral support, and coaching

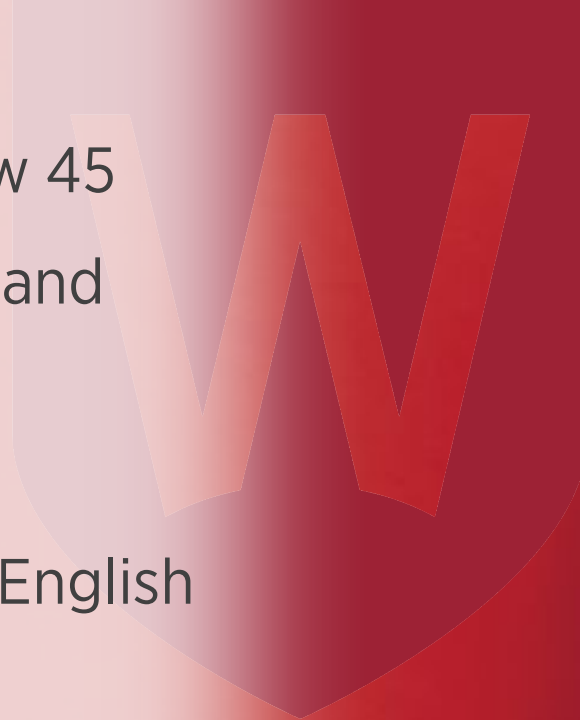


New Education Model Outcomes

- Class attendance 60% up 12% on traditional model
- Engagement in learning materials 75%
- Assessment submissions up 11%
- 99.3% passed (up 9.3%)
- Average pass rate 74% (up 21%)
- Retention rate of 76.7% (up 20.5%)
- 94% students agree developed critical and analytical thinking skills
- 98% overall student satisfaction

New Education Model Student Profile

- 91% of students with ATAR below 45
- No correlation between success and ATAR!
- 60% identify as female
- 67% speak language other than English
- 53% first in family at university
- 13% born overseas
- 88% aged 17-21
